


Proclamation

- WHEREAS,** The City of Cupertino wishes to show support for National Men's Health Week and Health Month;
- WHEREAS,** Despite advances in medical technology and research, men continue to live an average of five years less than women;
- WHEREAS,** Men who are educated about the value that preventative health can play in prolonging their lifespan will be more likely to participate in health screenings;
- WHEREAS,** Men's Health Network worked with Congress to develop this awareness period as a special campaign to help educate men, boys, and their families about the importance of positive health attitudes and preventative health practices;
- WHEREAS,** The City Council recognizes that Men's Health Month will focus on a broad range of men's health issues, including heart disease, mental health, diabetes, and prostate, testicular, and colon cancer.
- THEREFORE,** I, Mayor Darcy Paul, and the Cupertino City Council do hereby Proclaim the week ending on Father's Day as Men's Health Week and the month of June 2021 as
